YTY Ideal Classroom Scoring Rubric

Your 1st assignment is to write a nine paragraph 500 word paper on your ideal classroom. A paragraph should be developed on <u>each</u> of the first 9 sections listed below. The 10th section will be a drawing of the physical layout of your ideal classroom. You will receive a possible two points for each paragraph and for the drawing. **Spelling and grammatical errors will result in a loss of points!** All papers should be typed in size12 font (double spaced) and neat in appearance. Some of the more common topics to be discussed for each section are listed.

1st section - introductory paragraph of your idea of the perfect classroom (you may want to consider age level, grade, size of school, type of school, etc.)	/2
2nd section – describe the physical layout on your ideal classroom (location, desks, tables, centers, windows, floors, lights, computers, smart board, etc.)	/2
3rd section – create a daily/weekly time schedule of your ideal classroom (start/end time, specials, centers, whole group, small group, periods, block, mod, etc.)	/2
4th section – portray the class make up of your ideal classroom (ethnic groups, gender, number of students, special needs, diversity of staff, etc.)	/ 2
5th section – specify the dress and accessories code of your ideal classroom (appropriate clothing/uniforms, inappropriate clothing/accessories, cell phones, etc.)	/2
6th section – detail the yearly school calendar of your ideal classroom (traditional, year round, vacations, breaks, holidays, number of days of school, etc.)	/ 2
7th section – depict the curriculum taught in your ideal classroom (academics, arts, technology, behavioral, ethical, religious, field trip, after school, etc.)	/ 2
8th section – characterize the type of instruction teachers would use (computerized, hands on, lecture, labs, videos, boards, overheads, discussion, etc.)	/2
9th section – paint a picture of the atmosphere of your ideal classroom (help the reader to understand how they would feel as a part of your classroom)	/2
10th section - drawing of the physical layout of your ideal classroom - label all components in your diagram	/2
