## YTY ATTENDANCE & BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES

Daily attendance at YTY is required. The only reasons to miss your YTY assignment are:

- 1. Illness A parent must call the elementary/middle school in addition to North High, South High, Central High, Ideas, George Warriner, or Tower Academy.
- 2. Severe weather conditions (snow, sleet, extreme cold, tornado warning) A parent must call your YTY school prior to the start of school. If severe weather occurs during the school day, please call the school yourself and follow-up with a parental note/email upon your return. Report to the IMC instead.
- 3. Family illness/death/vacation/college visit Communication must be made to your supervising teacher. Extended absences should be communicated to your supervising teacher and the YTY Coordinator.
- 4. Field trip with high school class Prearrange this absence with both your supervising teacher and the YTY Coordinator.

Weekly/daily attendance checks will be monitored for all YTY students and records of YTY attendance maintained for each quarter.

Attendance at all YTY inservices is required. You do **not** go tutoring on inservice days. Nonattendance of these days is unexcused.

Your YTY times should **not** be used for appointments or to make up tests. Nonattendance on these days is unexcused.

**Appropriate Behavior and Dress during YTY is required**. As a role model and teacher helper you must represent yourself, your school, and the YTY program in a positive way at all times.

- 1. Clothing should be in accordance with your tutoring school dress code. (Ex. no inappropriate language or pictures, proper length, should not be revealing, etc.)
- 2. Talk and interact properly with the students and adults at your school. (Ex. no bad language, age level appropriateness, respectful, etc.)
- 3. You are there to help the teacher with the students, but discipline (writing referrals, calling home, consequences, etc.) is the teacher's responsibility.
- 4. Cell phones, iPods, food, drink, etc. are not appropriate items to bring to YTY.

Failure to meet and abide by the above attendance and/or behavior guidelines will be met with a lowered grade and/or removal from the YTY program. Please sign below to indicate you understand these guidelines and the possible consequences.
