Name of Course: Pre-Calculus 2
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## I. Course Content

This course is intended for students planning to pursue careers requiring a strong mathematical background. This course is a preparation for the study of calculus. Topics covered are functions, graphing, trigonometry, vectors, matrices, second degree relations, polynomials, logarithms, polar coordinates, and sequences/series.

Graphic calculators will be used extensively in this course. Students are strongly encouraged to purchase their own. The TI-83+ or TI-84+ is the recommended calculator, but other graphing calculators can also be used.
